## Written Personal Statements

Personal statements are an integral part of the Bellin College admission decision process. These personal statements provide you with an opportunity to share your perceptions and thoughts on the topics below. Your well-written statements will be an important part of your application and scholarship review. We are interested in seeing what drew you to Bellin College and why you are interested in the programs we have to offer.

At Bellin College, we have four values that guide our mindset and behaviors. Please think about these values as you answer the essay prompts. Our four values are:

- Excellence (being the best)
- Integrity (honest and ethical behavior)
- Community (partnership and shared participation)
- Caring (empowering relationships based on empathy and respect)

*Your responses will be used in your admission decision and scholarship review process.*

1. Tell us what you know about Bellin College and why you think it would be a good fit for you.
2. Bellin College stands by our four core values (Excellence, Integrity, Community and Caring), which do you identify with most? Write about a time when you demonstrated that value.
3. You will experience many different individuals in your profession and on campus. How will you ensure everyone is treated with dignity and respect?

## Video Essay

We are also asking applicants to submit a brief video essay answering the following questions:

1. What inspired you to pursue the program you're applying for?
2. How will you be successful in the program?
3. What kinds of study habits/techniques have you developed?

You will have 3 attempts to record this video and up to 10 minutes to answer all three questions.
