High School Students

Bellin College offers scholarships to undergraduate students with high academic achievements at the time of admission. Merit scholarships are based solely on academic performance and are to be used to pay for educational costs incurred while enrolled at Bellin College. Awards will be distributed over a student's entire enrollment at Bellin College and based upon the following scales*:

Additional Information:

- Only students identified as accepted applicants will be reviewed for Merit Scholarship eligibility.
- Awards are based on high school GPA and composite ACT (or equivalent SAT) scores. Reviews will begin when scores are available from the February ACT testing date and will continue on a rolling basis.
- The GPA will be based upon the student's GPA at the end of the first semester of the senior year of high school if the student is still enrolled.
- Merit scholarship eligibility is based upon the transcripts on file at the time of the official review, and is not amended based on subsequent transcripts received.
- Awards will be distributed in increasing increments for each year of enrollment at Bellin College, pending compliance with all award requirements.
- In order to retain eligibility for the merit scholarship, the cumulative Bellin College GPA must be a minimum of 3.50.
