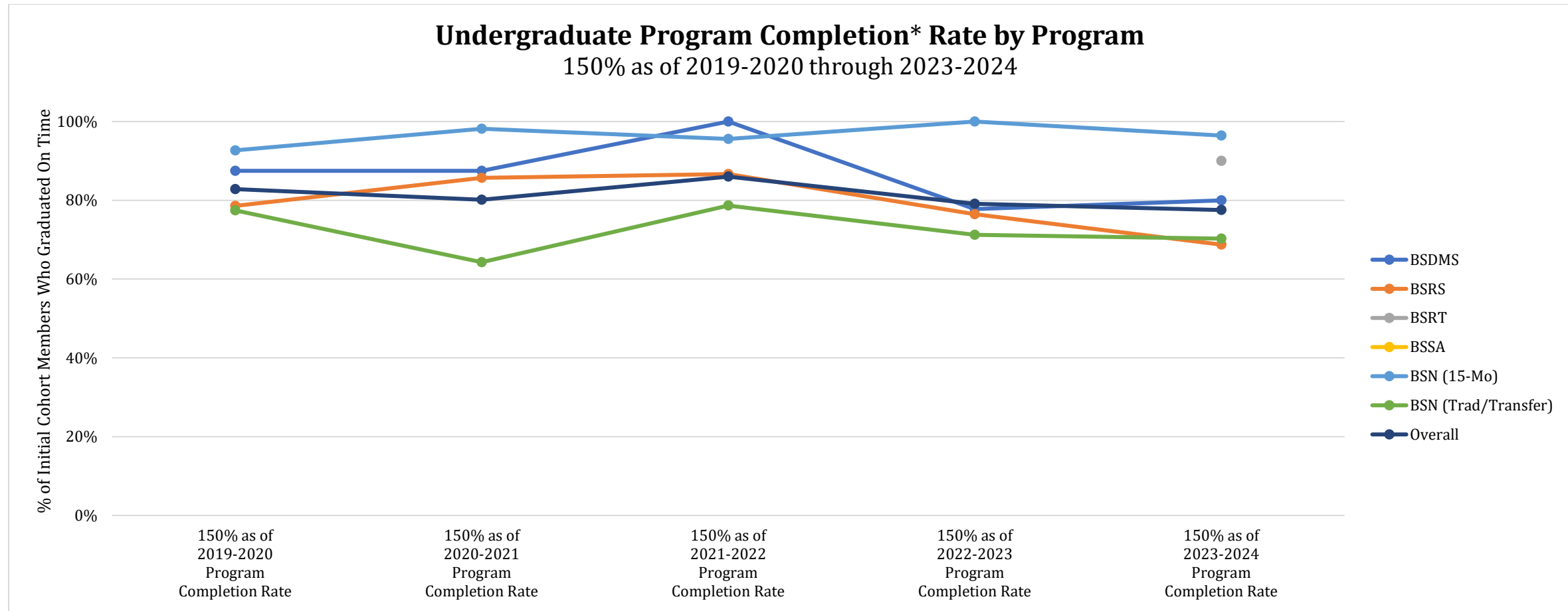


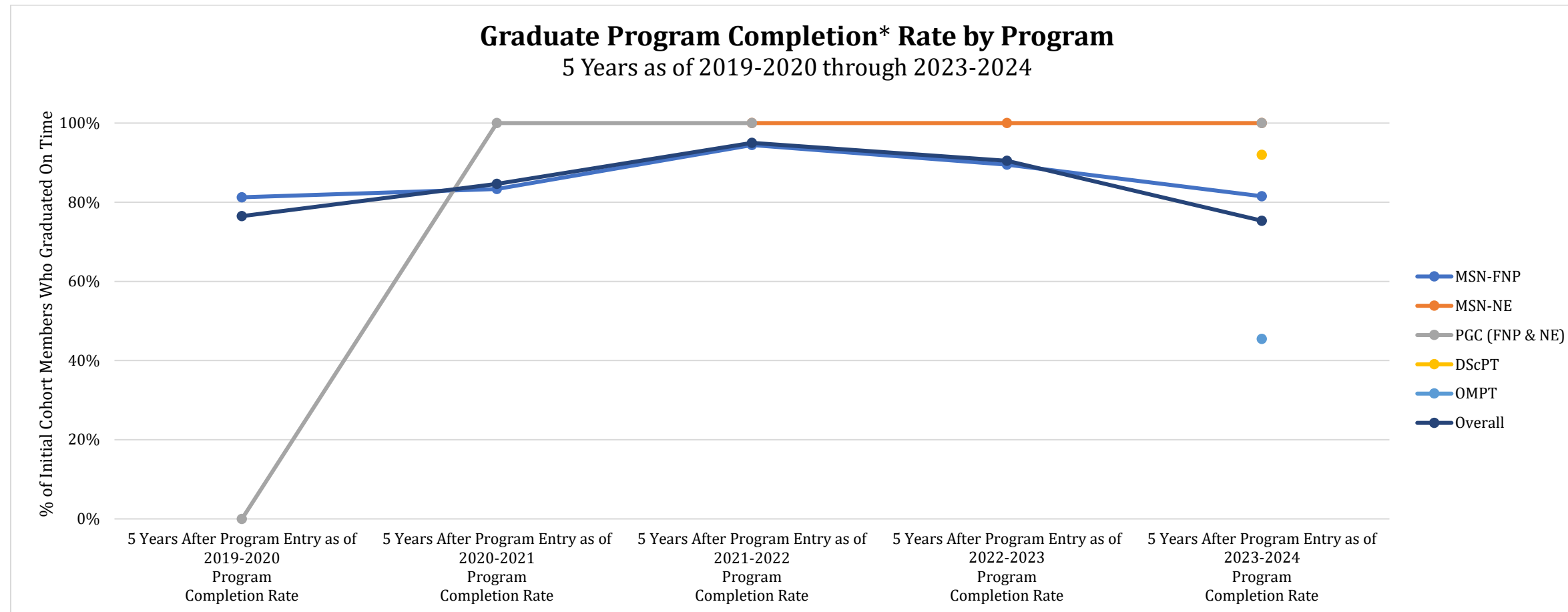

* The proportion of students who complete the program within 150% of the program graduation timeframe while maintaining continuous enrollment, but graduate after the defined parameters for the program of study; students with medical, military, or prior approved personal leaves of absences are exempt from the continuous enrollment requirement. Given the college's variety of program lengths, the timeframes are defined as being within 6 years for students in 4-year programs, within 4 years for students in 3-year programs, within 3-years for students in 2-year transfer programs, and within 2 years for students in 15-month programs. Students who leave the College or do not graduate for any reason (medical leave, military service, personal choice, etc.) are considered as not completing the program and are NOT excluded from the data.

* The proportion of students who complete the program within 5 years of program entry. This metric includes students in all graduate programs (Graduate Nursing PGC, BSN-MSN, MSN-DNP, DPT, DScPT, OMPT Fellowship) with the exception of the BSN-DNP program. Students in the BSN-DNP program will have 8 years to complete the program from the point of program entry, but the program was approved in 2021, so a within 8 years program completion rate will not be available until 2029. Because students in the college's graduate programs are often working professionals, and because plans of study may be individualized based on full-time or part-time enrollment, in addition to gap analyses for individual students, there is no one on-time graduation rate for most programs, and program completion within the allowed timeframe is the more meaningful metric.
